After applying the patches in #342 and #345 , running autoreconf -vif to rebuild the configure and Makefiles, configuring the project and running make -C doc/unitdoc html-local, from the top build directory to build the HTML documentation, make fails when building the target html-local when applying the final patch to the CSS: <pre>patch -p1 <../../..../doc/unitdoc/doxygen.css.patch patching file html/doxygen.css Hunk #1 FAILED at 944. 1 out of 1 hunk FAILED -- saving rejects to file html/doxygen.css.rej</pre> This might be due to a different version of doxygen being used and producing different CSS, but I have fixed this issue by creating a new doc/unitdoc/doxygen.css.patch file. The attached patch fixes this patch file at least when using doxygen version 1.8.13.
